

Lok Sabha passes bill to give constitutional status to NCBC

legislation comes ahead of the general election due early next year, reports PTI.

Over two-thirds majority voted in favour of the bill, which is a necessity for amending the Constitution.

A crucial bill to provide constitutional status to the National Commission for Backward Classes was passed unanimously by the Lok Sabha on Thursday with over two-third majority.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi, who was present during the voting, congratulated Social Justice and Empowerment Minister Thaanwar-hand Gehlot for successfully piloting the bill.

The bill provides for granting of constitutional status to the National Commission for Backward Classes (NCBC) on par with the National Commission for Scheduled Castes and the National Commission for Scheduled Tribes.

During the debate on the Constitution (123rd Amendment) Bill 2017, several members demanded a census to ascertain the population of other backward classes (OBCs) while some others pressed for making public the socio-economic survey of 2014.

incident and said that it was a cause for serious concern that alleged victims of sexual violence were interviewed a number of times and were made to repeat the incident.

"Is this the way we are treating our girls," the bench said and asked the media not to interview the alleged victims of sexual abuse at the shelter home while restraining them from telecasting or publishing the images of the victims even in morphed form.

"Now the probe has been handed over to the CBI. Will these girls be questioned in front of a camera? It is not easy for anybody. They have to relive the trauma. It is horrible," the bench observed and issued notices to the Centre and Bihar government seeking their responses on the incident.

"How you talk to a child is different from how you talk to an adult. I had yesterday seen a clip. You do not talk to an alleged victim of rape like this. There are different ways of talking," Justice Lokur said and questioned as to why these alleged victims should ever be interviewed like this.

The officers have been completely inept and insensitive in handling such sensitive cases. What is the point of the highest court in the state monitoring the case when the results are still unsatisfactory," Justice Dharmadhikari said.

The judges, while labelling the reports as 'rudimentary,' further said that despite the involvement of higher officials of the CBI and the SIT, they had only managed to compile summaries of all the progress reports submitted by the agencies, so far.

Meanwhile, the agencies have sought an adjournment for two months to place on record the steps they propose to undertake for achieving further progress in the case.

The bench, however, refused to allow the prayer to adjourn the hearing for two months and instead posted the matter for further hearing on September 3.

'Pregnant' woman gang raped by 'ex' and seven friends

He later informed that the woman, who had returned to her own house in Satara, has now accepted that she will undergo the requisite medical test. "We have sent our team comprising of women police officers to her house and a medical test will now be conducted there," the officer said.

The woman, however, has a very different story to tell. According to her FIR, she along with her husband, who runs a hotel, had been to Tasgaon to hire a couple for their business. There, one of the accused - Mukund - called her husband and asked him to come to Turchi Phata.

"Mane claimed that he knew a couple who would work under the victim and her husband. He had even asked us to bring an advance payment of Rs. 20000 to pay them," the FIR states.

However, given that the victim and her husband reached the spot, Mane and his friends assaulted them, locked the husband in a vehicle and then gang-raped her. The victim claimed that all the accused were 'influential' men in the locality.

Meanwhile, the state commission for women has summoned higher officials of the Sangli police and sought a detailed report in the incident.

The letter written by Vijaya Rahatkar, chairperson of the commission, stated, "The matter is serious and thus the Superintendent of Police should personally intervene and take suitable action. Also he should submit a report of action taken at the earliest."
